ORDER APPROVING SECOND ROUND OF DISTRIBUTIONS

Now before the Court is the parties' Joint Motion to Approve a Second Round of Distributions. ECF No. 51. After the Court previously requested supplemental briefing on a proposed *cy pres* distribution, ECF No. 48, the parties agreed to make a second round of distributions to 119,101 class members who cashed the original distribution checks, ECF No. 51. The parties propose making a *pro rata* distribution to those class members as well as making a distribution to the 492 class members who tried to cash the first round distribution checks after they had been automatically voided. ECF No. 51.

Finding that additional distributions to the identified class members are feasible and economically viable, the Court GRANTS the motion to approve a second round of distributions. *See In re BankAmerica Corp. Secs. Litig.*, 775 F.3d 1060, 1063–64 (8th Cir. 2015). The distributions shall occur in accordance with the plan outlined in the parties' motion and attachments. ECF No. 51. The parties shall provide the Court with an update on the distribution process every thirty (30) days.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
